Still, not everyone knows how to dance, and that's where Just Dance Now comes into another. This mobile spinoff of the hit console series brings more than 200 titles to iOS and Android smartphones, including Uptown Funk by Mark Ronson, Jailhouse Rock by Elvis Presley and (for some unfathomable reason) Hungarian Dance No. 5 by Johannes Brahms. I'm not particularly fond of spiders, either (too many eyes and legs for my taste), so the idea of depriving them of their meal seemed like a good enough prerequisite to give a whirl. The result is many an hour lost and homework neglected. Greedy Spiders is a turn-based puzzle game in which you (like some almighty, web-cutting force) try to outwit a spider (probably a greedy one) and keep him from his meal of winged insect. This is done by touching a piece of web to cut it away and therefore keep the spider from getting from place to place. Webs are set up in what I can best describe as a connect-the-dot format. There are points that cobwebs connect to, and it's at these points the spider can turn around, change directions, and the like. You also take turns with the spider, with your move always going first. You snip some web, the spider goes, you cut again, so on and so on. If your mistake is eaten, you lose. If you manage to save your bug (s) from the spider, though, you win and move on to the next level. You'll be rewarded with stars for completing a level, Angry Birds-style, with one star being the largest minimum and three stars for completely spaking some spider heiny. The game also ramps up in trouble, starts you off with only one bug to save and a spider tries to eat it. As you continue through the levels, you will be tasked with saving more than one bug (I'm at four right now) from a spider. Once you are all greased up and comfortable, however, you will have to start fighting with more than one spider trying to eat more than one bug. That's when it gets a little stressful. To ease your pain in later levels, sometimes you are rewarded with some powerful options and abilities, but they are limited. You can sometimes swing fire to burn large parts of the web away, put a dummy bug on the web to distract and fool a spider, or even invoke a supernatural power to teleport your mistakes from the internet. The last kind escapes me, but hey, it's at your disposal. Greedy is a pretty fun game. The graphics are well done, it's smooth and there's a lot of content to explore. Just when you think about thinking started to get the hang of things, another variable is introduced and you are back to square one, fighting for your error survival. There is both a free version and a paid version of Greedy Spiders, with the paid version running 99 cents. The free version has only 64 of the 128 levels, so if you don't mind starting over, you can play through the first 64 to make sure you enjoy it before using a buck to get the rest of the game. In my opinion it is another in the range of quality pseudo-puzzles on Android and is totally worth checking out.
